All-State Festival Choir — Joshua Haberman, Director

Joshua Habermann, Artistic Director, is in his fourteenth season with the Santa Fe Desert Chorale. Since joining the Chorale he has raised the ensemble's artistic profile and broadened its programming to include choral-orchestral masterworks as well as cutting-edge a cappella programs. Having joined the Dallas Symphony Orchestra in 2011, Joshua Habermann has held the Jean D. Wilson Chorus Director Chair since 2015. As Chorus Director, he prepares the 200-voice chorus for classical and pops series concerts. Highlights with the DSO include performances of Bach's St. Matthew Passion, Verdi's Requiem, Berlioz's Te Deum, and Britten's War Requiem, which was performed for the national meeting of the American Choral Directors Association in 2013. From 2008 to 2011 Joshua Habermann was Director of Choral Studies at the University of Miami Frost School of Music, where he led the graduate program in conducting and directed the Frost Chorale. Notable projects in Miami included collaborations with the New World Symphony and conductor Michael Tilson Thomas in the music of Ives, Schubert, and Beethoven. During this same period, Joshua Habermann led the Master Chorale of South Florida in performances of masterworks such as Mendelssohn's Elijah, Haydn's Creation, and Mozart's Requiem. From 1996-2008 Habermann was Assistant Conductor of the San Francisco Symphony Chorus, and Professor of Music at San Francisco State University, where under his direction the SFSU Chamber Singers undertook international engagements in Havana, Cuba, and concert tours in Germany, the Czech Republic, and China. In 2006 he led a collaboration between the SFSU Chamber Singers and the Orchestre des Jeunes de la Méditerranée in music of Poulenc and the Requiem of Maurice Duruflé in concerts throughout France. National invitations include the Waging Peace Festival in Eugene, OR, multiple appearances at the California Music Educators Convention, and an appearance at the American Choral Directors Association regional convention in 2008. Habermann has led honor choirs and choral festivals in North and Latin America, Europe, and Asia. As a singer he has performed with the Oregon Bach Festival Chorus (OR) and Conspirare (TX). Recording credits include three projects with Conspirare: Through the Green Fuse; Requiem, a GRAMMY® nominee for best choral recording in 2006; and Threshold of Night, a GRAMMY® nominee for best choral recording and best classical album in 2009. Recordings as a conductor include The Road Home (2018) and Rachmaninov's All-Night Vigil (2020), both with the Santa Fe Desert Chorale. A native of California, Joshua Habermann is a graduate of Georgetown University and the University of Texas at Austin, where he completed doctoral studies in conducting with Craig Hella Johnson. He lives in Honolulu with his wife Joanna, daughter Kira, and son Kai.

All-State Festival Orchestra — Jeffrey Grogan, Director



Jeffrey Grogan is an internationally-acclaimed conductor and teacher, currently serving as Director of Orchestral Activities at the Bass School of Music at Oklahoma City University and Artistic Director of the Oklahoma Youth Orchestra. Recently he was invited by the LA Philharmonic to conduct alongside Gustavo Dudamel at Disney Hall, a part of the Youth Orchestras of Los Angeles National Festival. Recent work includes conducting at the Sydney Opera House, Harpa Concert Hall in Iceland, and in Bangkok and Singapore.

Grogan serves as a Master Educator for the Yamaha Corporation of America and is also on the Advisory Committees of the Midwest Clinic and Music for All. Following his passion for performing and helping to create new music for orchestras, he has collaborated with many composers such as Lowell Liebermann, Michael Colgrass, Eric Whitacre, Steven Stucky, and Scott McAllister – as well as soloists Richard Stolzman, Stefan Hoskuldsson, Julian Schwarz, and the Canadian Brass. Grogan worked in studio and on several projects with

violinist and composer Mark O'Connor. Grogan recorded O'Connor's March of the Gypsy Fiddler with the Ahn Trio and New Jersey Youth Symphony on OMAC Records, which is played on classical music radio throughout the country. He previously served eleven seasons as Education and Community Engagement Conductor of the New Jersey Symphony Orchestra, and as Conductor and Artistic Director of the NJSO Youth Orchestras, the InterSchool Orchestras of New York and the New Jersey Youth Symphony. He was founding Artistic Director of two El Sistema inspired program in New Jersey, CHAMPS and the Paterson Music Project. Grogan taught for over a decade at the University of Michigan, Ithaca College, and Baylor University. He is also the former Associate Director of Bands and Marching Band Director at the University of Michigan and Baylor University.

All-State Festival Band — Dr. Sarah McKoin, Director



Dr. Sarah McKoin serves as the Director of Bands, Professor of Music and Chair of the conducting area at Texas Tech University. Her responsibilities include Conductor and Musical Director of the TTU Symphonic Wind Ensemble, administrating the graduate program in wind conducting, pedagogy and wind literature, while overseeing the university band program which include four concert bands, the 400-member Goin' Band and other athletic bands. Under Dr. McKoin's direction, the Symphonic Wind Ensemble has been featured at the Midwest Clinic, multiple Texas Music Educators Association Conferences, the North American Saxophone Alliance, the

College Music Society conference and several CBDNA conferences. Dr. McKoin's ensemble has received critical acclaim for their recordings on the Naxos and Albany label featuring world premiere recordings of the wind music of

Chen Yi and Narong Prangcharoen. Her interest in contemporary music has supported residencies, numerous consortiums and premieres of leading composers of our time. This fall, John Corigliano will be in residence in a special collaboration with Texas Tech University and the Lubbock Symphony where McKoin will conduct the heralded Symphony #3 "Circus Maximus" on a LSO subscription concert in the new world-class Buddy Holly Performing Arts Center. A world premiere recording of Israeli-American composer Avner Dorman's wind music is currently in production. Highly active and widely sought as a guest conductor and clinician, Dr. McKoin has traveled extensively throughout the United States and abroad. She has worked in China, Taiwan, Thailand, Canada, and Israel where she served as producer for the world premiere recording of Roberto Sierra's Fantasia Correliana with the Castellani-Andriaccio guitar duo and Israeli Chamber Orchestra. Additionally, McKoin served on the conducting faculty at the Brevard Music Center in Brevard, North Carolina for ten years and most recently, the Interlochen Arts Academy. She remains passionately committed to music education and has conducted numerous All-State ensembles throughout the country as well as being a regional and local music advocate. Prior to her appointment at Texas Tech, Professor McKoin held appointments at the University of Missouri-Kansas City Conservatory of Music, the State University of New York at Buffalo and SUNY Fredonia. She has served as President of the Southwest Division of the College Band Director's National Association and as President of the Big 12 Band Director's Association. She is a member of the Texas Music Educators Association, Texas Bandmasters Association, Phi Beta Mu, Pi Kappa Lambda, and serves as faculty sponsor of the service fraternities Kappa Kappa Psi and Tau Beta Sigma.
